

**Memorandum of Cooperation
between
STKIP PGRI Sumatera Barat (Indonesia) and
Providence University (Taiwan)**

STKIP PGRI Sumatera Barat (Indonesia) and Providence University (Taiwan), wishing to establish relations between the two institutions, agree to cooperate with each other as follows:

Scope of the Cooperation

Subject to mutual consent, the areas of cooperation will include any program offered at either institution as thought desirable and feasible on either side and that both sides think will contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two institutions.

Cooperation shall be carried out through such activities as:

- a. Development of institutional management
- b. Development of faculty and/or staff
- c. Participation in cultural exchange activities
- d. Cooperation in student admission and scholarship application

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this Memorandum of Cooperation shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such agreements entered into, as outlined above, will form appendixes to this Memorandum of Cooperation. Each institution shall designate a liaison officer to develop and coordinate the specific activities and programs agreed upon.

Renewal, Termination and Amendment

This Memorandum of Cooperation shall remain in force for an indefinite time from the date of the final signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving 12 months notice to the other party in writing, unless an earlier termination date is mutually agreed upon. The Memorandum of Cooperation may be amended or extended between two parties in writing as an addendum to this agreement.
